

SINGLE COUNTY DITCH PETITION

Revised Code, Secs. 6131.04; 6133.02, .03

Sandusky County, Ohio, _____, 20__

To the Board of County Commissioners, Sandusky County, Ohio:

The undersigned hereby petitions your honorable body ... to provide, in a manner deemed to be most conducive to public welfare, an improvement for the disposal or removal of surplus water and/or to provide an outlet for field tile for the adjoining watershed to be known as the Michaels Ditch, utilizing any, all, or a combination of the methods provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 6131.01 (C) (1) (2) (3) (4) (5) necessary for the disposal of surplus water.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, will benefit the petitioner(s), and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit: The proposed project begins approximately 1850' east and 1920' north of the southwest corner of Section 28 of Jackson Township at a point on the existing ditch on the northern property line of parcel 14280000900; Thence following the path of the ditch east approximately 270'; Thence north approximately 720'; Thence west approximately 370'; Thence north approximately 2185' joining with the ditch along the railroad; thence northwest approximately 570' to Muskellunge Creek where a sufficient outlet is provided and the project will terminate.

All costs of engineering, construction, and future maintenance will be assessed to the benefitting parcels of land, except as ordered under Section 6131.31 of the Revised Code.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for: Reconstruction of the existing watercourse or construction of a new watercourse utilizing open ditch and/or pipe with an evaluation of any existing structure/pipe on the watercourse to make the channel adequate to serve its watershed as is reasonable and feasible.
