**An amendment to the Winters Ditch #181 Single County Ditch Petition:**

**Whereas:**

To make an application to the Board of County Commissioners of Sandusky County to extend the proposed drainage improvement currently under county petition to extend the petition to the south and starting at the beginning of Winters Ditch

Said application for an amendment to the current Winters Ditch #181 petition is as follows:

The amendment, Winters Extension #1, commences at the West side of Township Road 80 and North side of Norfolk & Western Rwy. Co. railroad, approximately 1,045 ft. South of the west quarter post of Section 33, Jackson Township, Sandusky County, Ohio; thence following the route of existing open ditch for approximately 1,045 feet to the North; thence turning Easterly and crossing under Township Road 80; thence following the route of existing open ditch, in an Easterly direction, for approximately 1,043 ft.; thence turning and heading in a Northeasterly direction, along Norfolk & Western Rwy. Co. railroad, for approximately 360 ft.; thence turning and heading in a Northerly direction for approximately 680 ft.; thence turning and heading in a Northeasterly direction for approximately 728 ft. to Township Road 86; thence crossing under Township Road 86 and continuing in a Northeasterly direction for approximately 292 ft.; thence turning and heading in an Easterly direction for approximately 542 ft.; thence turning and heading in a Northeasterly direction, along the Norfolk & Western Rwy. Co. railroad, for approximately 1,100 ft.; thence turning and heading in an Easterly direction for approximately 45 ft.; thence coming to an inlet of a 30 inch RCP at Douglas Street, Burgoon Ohio; thence crossing under Douglas Street in a Northeasterly direction, through approximately 45 ft. of 30 inch RCP, into a 2-3 catch basin; thence continuing in a Northeasterly direction, through approximately 306 ft. of 30 inch RCP, into a 2-3 catch basin; thence continuing in a Northeasterly direction, through approximately 54 ft. of 30 inch RCP, into a 2-3 catch basin; thence continuing in a Northeasterly direction, through approximately 45 ft. of 27 inch RCP, into a 2-3 catch basin; thence turning and heading in a Easterly direction, along the south side of County Road 13, through approximately 160 ft. of 27 inch RCP, into a 6 ft. by 8 ft. junction chamber; thence continuing in a Easterly direction, along the south side of County Road 13, through approximately 176 ft. of 38 inch by 60 inch ERCP, into a 6 ft. by 8 ft. junction chamber; thence continuing in a Easterly direction, along the south side of County Road 13, through approximately 171 ft. of 38 inch by 60 inch ERCP, into a 6 ft. by 8 ft. junction chamber; thence continuing in a Easterly direction, along the south side of County Road 13, through approximately 109 ft. of 38 inch by 60 inch ERCP, into a 6 ft. by 8 ft. junction chamber; thence continuing in a Easterly direction, along the south side of County Road 13, through approximately 119 ft. of 38 inch by 60 inch ERCP, into a 6 ft. by 8 ft. junction chamber; thence turning and heading in a Northeasterly direction, through approximately 72 ft. of 43 inch by 68 inch ERCP, across County Road 13; thence continuing in a Northeasterly direction, through approximately 60 ft. of 60 inch N-12 pipe; thence terminating into the existing open channel of Winters Ditch.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for:

... an improvement in a manner deemed to be most conducive to public welfare of the watercourse to be known as Winters Ditch, utilizing any, all or a combination of the methods provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 6131.01 (C) (1) (2) (3) (4) (5) necessary for the disposal of surplus water.
