RE: Buckland Ave Water Line Extension Project

To Whom It May Concern:

The City of Fremont is pleased to announce that a new water line will be installed on Buckland Ave to service the new Lutz Elementary School. The school property is currently serviced by a ground water well, which is insufficient to meet the schools needs particularly the require fire suppression requirements. This water line will be installed from the existing water line at intersection of Buckland and Third out to the intersection of Buckland and Tucker Road. During the installation of the Raw Water line from the Reservoir to the Water Treatment plant, a portion of water line was installed for future connection, which this project will accomplish. As a benefit, all the residents and businesses along Buckland will have the option to tap into the new water line if desired. If there is desire to tap into the new water line now, please contact the City to discuss your interest.

The City of Fremont's Water/Sewer Department will be performing the construction of this new water line and anticipate the work beginning the first week of June and potentially lasting through August. During construction, your dives will be accessible with exception to short periods when the trench and construction equipment is working directly in front of the drives and intersections.
