RESOLUTION ---- AWARDING BID TO PRESTRESS SERVICES INDUSTRIES, LLC, OF LEXINGTON, KY., FOR THE MANUFACTURE, STORAGE, DELIVER AND ERECTION OF A PRESTRESSED CONCRETE BRIDGE SUPERSTRUCTURE

The Board of County Commissioners, Sandusky County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 22nd day of December, 2011 at the offices of the Board with the following members present:

Commissioner Polter moved the adoption of the following resolution:

Whereas, pursuant to the County Engineer requesting same, bid proposals were received on 12.20.2011 for the aforementioned bridge superstructure for RY 232-3.19, and,

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners in conjunction with the County Engineer, after review of the bids, finds the lowest and best bid to have been offered by Prestress Services Industries, LLC, and,

Whereas, a search of the Auditor of State database finds no finding for recovery levied against the aforementioned company, and,

Whereas, the County Engineer, has recommended that the award be made to Prestress Services Industries, LLC in the amount of \$89,480.00.

THEREFORE; Be It Resolved,

Section 1. The Sandusky County Board of Commissioners authorizes that the bid award for the manufacture, storage, delivery and erection of a prestressed concrete bridge superstructure for RY 232-3.19, be made to Prestress Service Industries, LLC, of Lexington, Ky. The award amount is \$89,480.00.

Section 2. This resolution shall be copied to Prestress Service Industries, LLC, P.O. Box 55436, Lexington, KY. 40555, to the County Engineer's Office and to Norman Solze, Assistant Prosecutor.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Board concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were so adopted in an open meeting of this Board, and that all formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.
