## FROM THE DEPUTY ENGINEER

The second public hearing for the proposed \$5 Permissive License Tax was held last Thursday June 28<sup>th</sup>. Jerri Miller our County Auditor was the only one in attendance. We were all surprised to hear at this hearing that the Commissioners were not ready to support this tax at this time. They voted to delay their decision to a later date and to have more discussion on the subject. As a result the July 1<sup>st</sup> deadline will not be met and funds will not be available from this tax until 2020 at the earliest. We hope to have more discussions with the Commissioners and the public to answer any questions they might have regarding this license fee. If approved, the proposed \$300,000 that this license fee could collect will go a long way towards keeping up with our infrastructure in the future.

I attended the Ballville and Sandusky Township's bid opening of Poormans Subdivision paving on Tuesday night. They received two bids from Gerken Paving and Erie Blacktop. The low bid was from Gerken Paving for \$140,808.50. Erie's bid came in at \$150,895.50. The engineers estimate for this project was \$145,000.
