## FROM THE DUPTY ENGINEER

We finally had some decent weather last week and the beginning of this week. M&B was able to get some productive days of paving on CR 92 & CR 109. All of CR 92 has been paved and bermed. All of CR 109 has been scratched, and most of it covered with the surface course. We have about one more good day of paving left to cover all of the mainline. Some of the berming has also been completed on CR 109. Let's hope that we get good weather next week to complete this paving project. M&B is planning to leave the county and complete some of their state jobs. They plan to comeback in July to pave the CR 247, 260 & 268 project. Also, they plan to pave the CR 41 project in late August and September. We will have a pre-construction meeting with M&B to determine their exact schedule on CR 41 in the near future.

Jim, Matt and I attended the final hearing of the Cedar Ridge petition ditch project at the Commissioner's Office. After much deliberation by the property owners involved and the Commissioners, the Commissioners unanimously decided to approve and construct the project as presented by our office. The property owners have now 21 days to appeal the decision of the Commissioners. If nobody appeals it, we will then go out to bids and build the project accordingly. If the project gets built, the property owners involved will be assessed for the cost of the construction of the project. The engineers estimate to construct this project is \$14,150.00

Currently we are working on paving plans for a paving project between The City of Clyde, Green Creek Township and Sandusky County. Our portion would be the paving of Limerick between SR 101 and CR 175. This project is scheduled to open bids June 24, 2014. We are also working on a pavement markings contract which will be smaller than other years. The following Townships asked to be included with our contract: Green Creek, Sandusky, Townsend, Woodville, and York. We are also working on the designs of the RY 226 bridge and the Stahl Road petition project.

## FROM THE ROAD SUPERINTENDENT

### ROAD MAINTENANCE

- The rest of the dirt from the CR 247 bridge was hauled to Fangboner Rd. for some shoulder improvements.
- A 30" culvert was replaced on CR 247. There is still some work to do on a 24" tile and then this road will be ready for resurfacing.
- Two catch basins and a tile were repaired on East State St.
- A 12" culvert at the intersection of CR 247 and TR 238 was replaced.
- Culverts on CR 247 and TR 238 were flooded and paved.
- Culverts on Fangboner Rd. were paved.
- A sink hole on CR 198 was dug up.
- A catch basin was installed on CR 177 south west of TR 292.
- Yard and areas around town are being kept mowed.

- A new walk in door was installed in building #1. Gutters and down spouts were repaired on building #3.
- We have been experimenting with the crack seal material and cold mix recently. In the areas we have tried this we have not had any problem with the mix popping out. Today we are on CR 175 filling in some larger pot holes.
- Next week, road mowers will be out working on the first round.
