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## FROM THE ENGINEER

In regard to the new job descriptions, as expected, one person applied for Road Superintendent, one for Assistant, two for Mechanic, two for Foreman and one for Maintenance Worker I. The real surprise was for Maintenance Worker III which eleven people applied for. We'll start sorting through those next week.

In other news, work has started on the Alley Ditch (where we hope to get some dirt to finish 177). We received \$14,485 from the "salt settlement". Today we met with the consulting engineer on the Schwochow Ditch. Yesterday I attended a seminar at ODOT in Bowling Green about using liquids as de-icers. ## FROM THE ROAD SUPERINTENDENT

- Berm work on CR 177 has now been completed. Yards were cleaned up, large chunks were picked up and disposed of, and a seeder was rented to seed these berm areas.
- Mowing over west continues. Now more and more crops are coming off, which is allowing us to mow more of the back banks. Along with that, the boom mower is still working on back banks and the larger ditches as well.
- An area on CR 128 that was slipping and breaking down was dug out and paved.
- Maintenance work is being done to JA 7 – 0.12. Areas that are rusting are being sandblasted and painted.
- Dirt berm was added at the intersection of CR 185 and TR 195 after paving.
- Some minor dirt work and berm work was taken care of on Brush St. and Tucker Rd.
- Jeff and I attended the annual Superintendent and Mechanics Conference this week.
