## FROM THE ROAD SUPERINTENDENT

Dirt work was completed on CR 185 around the curve at the cemetery. Also, areas on Finefrock, Limerick, and Maple St. were dirt bermed after paving was completed. All of these areas have now been seeded with our hydro seeder. Since paving has been completed, a couple of new spots have come up that will need dirt to back up the berm. Guys are starting today hauling dirt from the Miller Ditch to these areas.

A 60 inch culvert was extended on TR 93 and the ditch was relocated. The guys had to fight a pretty good water flow in the ditch plus about 6 inches of rain that fell in the area last week. A large 6 inch pump that was rented and our 4 inch pump helped maintain the water. Things have shaped up pretty well out there this week. The area where the old channel was is still pretty wet and will have to dry out before we can final grade this area. The rest of the job will be getting seed today.

### ROAD MAINTENANCE

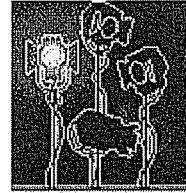

- All the rumble strips were cut in on Finefrock, Limerick, and CR 181.
- A new power washer was purchased.
- The backhoes were power washed and serviced.
- Ditch banks on CR 128 were hydro seeded.
- Culverts on CR 198 are being inspected for replacement.
