FROM THE ROAD SUPERINTENDENT

This week we moved the excavator to TR 278 where we are extending a 36" RCP culvert. Part of the project includes building a 6'x6' catch basin to be able to line the pipe up with the ditch. This project will also help with filling in a steep ditch bank next to the road. The basin should be pretty close to being finished today.

On CR 119, between TR 174 and 170, on the north side of the road, a lot of the road edges were really breaking up. So yesterday, with the help of York Twp. and their grader, we peeled out all the damaged areas. It was approximately 1300 feet long. We then used the widening machine to fill in these areas with some base asphalt. There is still some cleanup work to do yet, but this project came out really nice.

ROAD MAINTENANCE

- Concrete repairs were completed on bridges around the county.
- To. 237-1.12 bridge is being sandblasted and painted.
- Berm dragging and reclaiming is going on in the southwest corner of the county.
- Misc. spots on CR 89 and CR 175 were milled and filled with asphalt.
- High berms on CR 30, in front of the quarry, were shaved down.
- Mowers are back out on the west side of the county.
- Ed has completed mowing our roads with the boom mower. He is now working in Green Creek Twp. and will then be moving into Riley Twp.
- Dirt work along the road side on TR 220 is now complete. Everything has also been seeded.
