

RESOLUTION 2021 - 163

AWARDING BID TO PRESTRESS SERVICES OF COLUMBUS, OHIO FOR THE 2021 MANUFACTURE, STORAGE, DELIVERY, & ERECTION OF PRESTRESSED CONCRETE OR STEEL BEAM BRIDGE SUPERSTRUCTURES FOR JA 80-1.88 PROJECT

The Board of County Commissioners, Sandusky County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 6th day of May, 2021 at the offices of the Board with the following members present:

Commissioner Schwochow moved the adoption of the following resolution:

Whereas, pursuant to the County Engineer requesting same, bid proposals were received on May 4, 2021 for the aforementioned 2021 Manufacture, Storage, Delivery, & Erection Of Prestressed Concrete Or Steel Beam Bridge Superstructures For JA 80-1.88 Project, and,

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners in conjunction with the County Engineer, after review of the bids, recommends the bid be awarded to Prestress Services of Columbus, Ohio, and,

Whereas, a search of the Auditor of State database finds no finding for recovery levied against the aforementioned company and furthermore finds no debarment issue, and,

Whereas, the County Engineer, has recommended that the award be made to Prestress Services of Columbus, Ohio in the amount of \$120,200.00.

THEREFORE; Be It Resolved,

Section 1. The Sandusky County Board of Commissioners authorizes that the bid award for 2021 Manufacture, Storage, Delivery, & Erection Of Prestressed Concrete Or Steel Beam Bridge Superstructures For JA 80-1.88 Project be made to Prestress Services of Columbus, Ohio. The award amount is \$120,200.00

Section 2. This resolution shall be copied to Prestress Services, 250 North Hartford Ave, Columbus, Ohio 43222, to the County Engineer's Office and to Beth Tischler, Sandusky County Prosecutor.
