To the Board of County Commissioners, Sandusky County, Ohio:

The undersigned hereby petitions your honorable body ...
for an improvement in a manner deemed to be most conducive to public welfare of the watercourse to be known as Henry Kiser Ditch utilizing any, all or a combination of the methods provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 6131.01 (C) (1) (2) (3) (4) (5) necessary for the disposal of surplus water.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, will benefit the petitioner(s), and will be conducive to the public welfare.

The following is the course and termini of said proposed improvement, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the existing ditch approximately 680 feet west of the Center of Section, Section 12, T4N, R14E, Jackson Township, Sandusky County, Ohio; thence following the route of the existing open ditch in an Easterly direction approximately 680 feet to Sandusky County Road 12; thence continuing in an Easterly direction approximately 1,765 feet along or near the east-west half-section line of said Section 12; thence in a Southerly direction about 500 feet to the junction with Branch Number 1; thence Northeasterly through the NE part of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 12, approximately 940 feet to the east section line of Section 12 and the west section line of Section 7, T4N, R15E, Ballville Township, Sandusky County, Ohio; thence in an Easterly and Northerly direction approximately 3,220 feet to the west side of Township Road 126; thence Northerly, along the west side of Township Road 126, approximately 370 feet; thence crossing under Township Road 126 and going in an Easterly and Northerly direction approximately 5,025 feet to the south side of Sandusky County Road 41, approximately 635 feet east of the north $\frac{1}{4}$ Post of said Section 7; thence in an Easterly direction along the south side of County Road 41 approximately 185 feet to a 48" X 76" elliptical pipe; thence crossing under County Road 41 and going in an Easterly and Northerly direction approximately 5,725 feet to the inlet of a culvert on the west side of State Route 53, approximately 730 feet south of the North line of said Ballville Township; thence crossing under State Route 53 and going in an Easterly and Northerly direction approximately 950 feet to the inlet of a culvert on the south side of Sandusky County Road 6 (Hayes Avenue), approximately 340 feet east of State Route 53 and there terminate.

All costs of engineering, construction, and future maintenance will be assessed to the benefitting parcels of land, except as ordered under Section 6131.31 of the Revised Code.

The following is the nature of the work petitioned for:

... an improvement in a manner deemed to be most conducive to public welfare of the watercourse to be known as Henry Kiser Ditch utilizing any, all or a combination of the methods provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 6131.01 (C) (1) (2) (3) (4) (5) necessary for the disposal of surplus water.
