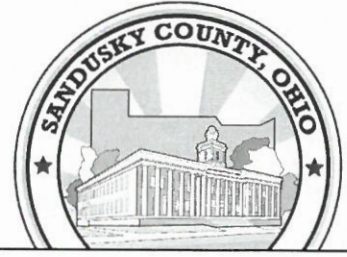

## DITCH IMPROVEMENT NOTICE

January 2, 2024

### VIEW AND FIRST HEARING – RACCOON CREEK #231

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TO THE OWNERS OF LAND AFFECTED BY THE PROPOSED IMPROVEMENT:

On October 4, 2023, a petition was filed to clean the RACCOON CREEK #231 to make it adequate to serve its watershed, in a reasonable and feasible way. Located in York Township, Sandusky County, Ohio. The construction of the improvement is necessary, will benefit the watershed, will be conducive to the public welfare, and petitions for the making of such improvement on the following course and termini, to-wit:

*Main Channel-Commencing at a point on the existing ditch on T.R. 276 approximately 1,287 ft north of the intersection with C.R. 113 and T.R. 276 near the east line of Section 32 in T4N and R17E, York Township, Sandusky County, Ohio; thence heading in a southwesterly direction for approx. 2,827 ft. before crossing T.R. 270 and heading in a westerly direction for approx. 2,988 ft. until crossing T.R. 266; thence heading in a northwesterly direction for approx. 2,800 feet before crossing under the RR and continuing in a northerly direction for 2,560 feet turning west and crossing under TR 262; thence heading in a west/southwesterly direction for approx. 2,850 feet turning north and heading under CR 177; thence continuing in a northwesterly direction for about 1,300 feet and terminating on the west side of TR 260 at the junction of the Alley Maintenance Ditch and Raccoon Creek with a total distance of approx. 3.0 miles.*

*Lateral-Commencing at a point on the existing lateral approximately, 740 feet east of the South ¼ post of section 29 in York Township. Thence heading west approx. 740 feet crossing under TR 270 heading in a westerly direction 2,755 feet to TR 266 crossing under the road and continuing in a west/south westerly direction for 2,100 ft and out letting into the main channel described above with a total distance of approx. 1.06 miles.*


This project is draining land in Sandusky and Seneca Counties. A joint board was formed on November 2, 2023, including all the Seneca and Sandusky County Commissioners. According to the Ohio Revised Code 6131, Sandusky County will be the lead county on this project.

The Raccoon Creek Joint Board of County Commissioners has slated a drone “VIEW” of the proposed Raccoon Creek for January 24, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. at the office of the Sandusky County Engineer, 2500 West State Street in Fremont Ohio, 43420. The Commissioners will be viewing the project on site at a prior time. The “FIRST HEARING” will be on April 17, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. in the office of the Sandusky County Engineer at 2500 W. State St. in Fremont, Ohio, 43420.

Please note that the VIEW is slated for interested parties to simply see the proposed improvement and look at pictures of the project. The FIRST HEARING is the time to raise questions and offer comments.
